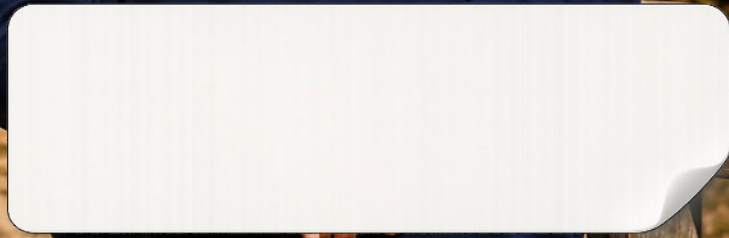

ACT ON THE AUDITS

END THE PORK

REFUND LOCAL GOVERNMENT

As savings are realized they should flow into the ad valorem reimbursement fund for local governments to remain whole.

LOWER MILLAGES RESPONSIBLY

Millage levels should be reduced in a responsible, phased manner that avoids shifting the tax burden elsewhere.

ELIMINATE THE TAX ON HOMESTEADS AND AG LAND

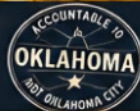
The goal is full elimination of property tax on homestead property and agricultural land.
